- If you are a worker with an H-2A visa, you are considered to be lawfully present in the United States.
- You are required to purchase health insurance or pay a tax penalty, unless you qualify for an exemption.
- You may be eligible for assistance to help pay for your plan.
- If you arrive in the U.S after the enrollment period, you have 60 days to enroll in a plan after your arrival. This opportunity is called a Special Enrollment Period.

Essential Health Benefits Your Plan Can Cover:

- Health care provider visits
- Hospitalizations (including surgeries)
- Emergency services
- Rehabilitative services (to treat injuries, disabilities or chronic conditions)
- Pediatric care (infants, children and adolescents)
- Mental health treatment
- Preventive care (routine vaccinations, health screenings, etc.)
- Prescription and medications
- Prenatal care, and much more.
